

Road Crashes Caused by Potholes in India¹

The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, through its annual 'Road Accidents in India' report, provides data on road crashes caused due to potholes on roads.

A total of **38,105** road crashes occurred due to potholes from 2013-2016 which resulted in **36,421** injuries and **11,386** deaths.
