Job Description

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Manage a team of crash investigators to conduct road crash investigations in different parts of the country.
- Review the existing crash investigation tools and procedures and recommend improvements.
- Provide technical guidance on design and implementation of crash investigation training modules.
- Undertake select crash investigation on specific cases as and when deployed.
- Coordinate with Police, hospitals and other agencies to collect required data for completing crash investigation.
- Store and analyze data from crash investigations to provide insights into the causes of road crashes, type of crash, injury coding etc.
- Facilitate and guide research to identify counter-measures to eliminate causes of road crashes.
- Prepare reports for internal and external stakeholders around road crashes.
- Give inputs for new projects around road safety and emergency care.
- Carry out any other duties and responsibilities as maybe assigned.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- Minimum 6 years' experience of crash scene and vehicle examination: data collection, equipment used, practices and procedures followed.
- Minimum 5 years' experience of road crash investigation reconstruction and software used for the same.

- Ability to develop administrative, technical and investigative skills.
