## CAREER OPPORTUNITY

SaveLIFE Foundation (SLF) is a non-profit organisation committed to saving lives on roads in India. We have been recognised as the *Best NGO in India* by the Rockefeller Foundation and are a recipient of the prestigious Prince Michael International Road Safety Award. We partner directly with the government, industry, and local communities across India to make the most dangerous roads safer.

Road crashes kill over 1.3 million people globally each year. India holds the dubious distinction of being world number one in road crash deaths, with at least 150,000 fatalities and over one million serious injuries per year. Most victims come from extremely poor backgrounds. Road crashes have emerged as the number one cause of death for Indians in the age-group of 15-45, dealing a crushing blow to the nation's productivity and a loss of 3% to our GDP each year - an amount that can eradicate hunger from India, twice over each year. Tragically, road crashes in India are also one of the biggest causes of death for children under age 14, with over twenty fatalities each day, mostly in the vicinity of schools.

SLF operates at the intersection of policy-making and grassroots impact. We are best known for getting India a Good Samaritan Law that encourages bystanders to help critically injured persons on the road, expected to save 50% lives otherwise lost to preventable injuries. Most recently, SLF has delivered an astounding **43% reduction in fatalities** on the Mumbai-Pune Expressway through a combination of measures ranging from improved road engineering, to technology-driven traffic enforcement to optimised trauma response – the **Zero Fatality Corridor (ZFC) model**.

### **ABOUT ZERO FATALITY CORRIDOR:**

The aim of the “Zero Fatality Corridor” initiative is to reduce the number of road crash fatalities on the deadliest roads of the countries to near zero level. SLF currently has ongoing ZFC projects in Maharashtra on the Mumbai Pune Expressway and NH-48, and Delhi on the 12 km stretch between Signature Bridge and Bhalswa Chowk and in Uttar Pradesh on the Yamuna Expressway. The ZFC initiative is executed by implementing a 360-degree road safety solution across the 4 E's of Road Safety – Engineering, Enforcement, Emergency Care and Education in close coordination with multiple stakeholders. Among other things we also use Tactical Urbanism (TU) to test soft interventions on high fatality traffic intersections in order to make them safer. SLF is executing multiple TU projects across these three states.

### **ABOUT TACTICAL URBANISM:**

‘Tactical Urbanism (TU)’ Trials are an internationally proven technique that helps test out soft interventions (using barricades, paints and cones). Following the assessment of the success and impact of these Trials, design proposals for permanent implementation can be made. These Trials aim to increase road safety for all road users, including vehicle drivers, pedestrians, cyclists and public transit users by temporary road design and infrastructural improvements.

**ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES: (DETAILED DESCRIPTION)**

SLF is seeking a full-time consultant on contract for a period of two years (extendable thereafter on mutual agreement) to lead the tactical redesign of road junctions at a selection of sites across the country. The work will include effective implementation of Tactical Urbanism trials-finalising the project goals internally; creating redesign drawings; conducting on-ground redesign including, coordinating the procurement and storage of high quality materials; planning installation of traffic barriers and cones; supervision at project site for the Urban Design Trials. The work also includes supervising observational studies; recording data at the site before and after the trials; analysis of the project impact; and community outreach activities.

The urban design consultant will have following specific responsibilities:

- Studying existing infrastructural conditions and road user behaviour at the selected sites. Mapping, surveying and documenting all the issues and commissioning the Road Safety Audit for detailed site assessment and road user behaviour studies.
- Finalise Project Goals, Impact Metrics and the Plan of Action for each selected site.
- Creation of Conceptual, Preliminary and Final Design Drawings, and coordinate to ensure statutory approvals for the same.
- Finalise vendors and technical consultants (contractor, research agency, transport planning agency, community outreach agency)
- Plan community outreach in schools and public community spaces in areas around the site.
- Coordinate procurement of materials, site preparation and execution work on-site
- Oversee on- site Execution of the project based on the final design drawings (CAD files). This includes all the approved soft interventions such as painting, installation of cones and barricades, etc.
- Analysis of the Impact of the Project post execution to document the reduction in conflict and attenuation of the causal risk factors at site.
- Collection of all relevant data along with an analysis, and documenting the same in a report format.
